

TOP 10 REASONS TO REVIEW / UPDATE YOUR ESTATE PLAN

- 10. Your will leaves everything to your wife . . . but you got divorced two years ago.
 - Change in family composition: birth, death, divorce, remarriage, adoption
- 9. You set up a trust to pay for your kids' college . . . now the grandkids are in college.
 - Change in needs of beneficiaries
 - Planning opportunities/challenges with multi-generational beneficiaries
- 8. You named your parents as your children's guardians . . . they're in a nursing home.
 - Changes in named fiduciaries: executor, trustee, agent under PoA/AMD, guardian
- 7. You moved to another state / country.
 - Make sure estate plan is compliant with laws of new jurisdiction of residence
- 6. You have purchased a vacation home in another state.
 - Assets (esp. real estate) in other jurisdictions can pose problems, without planning
- 5. Your powers of attorney / advance medical directives do not reflect changes in law.
 - There have been significant changes in Virginia law over the past several years
- 4. You have or are getting new life insurance policies.
 - Provide protection of trust for family / beneficiaries
 - Beneficiary designations must work in harmony with estate plan
- 3. You changed jobs or retirement accounts.
 - Make sure beneficiary designations are done properly
- 2. You can't remember what your estate plan says.
- 1. You can't find your estate plan.
